

Boronia Point

Walk Signage Colour: Light Blue

Length: 4.6 km return

Elevation Change: 100 m

Time: 1½ hours

Grade: Easy

Starting point:

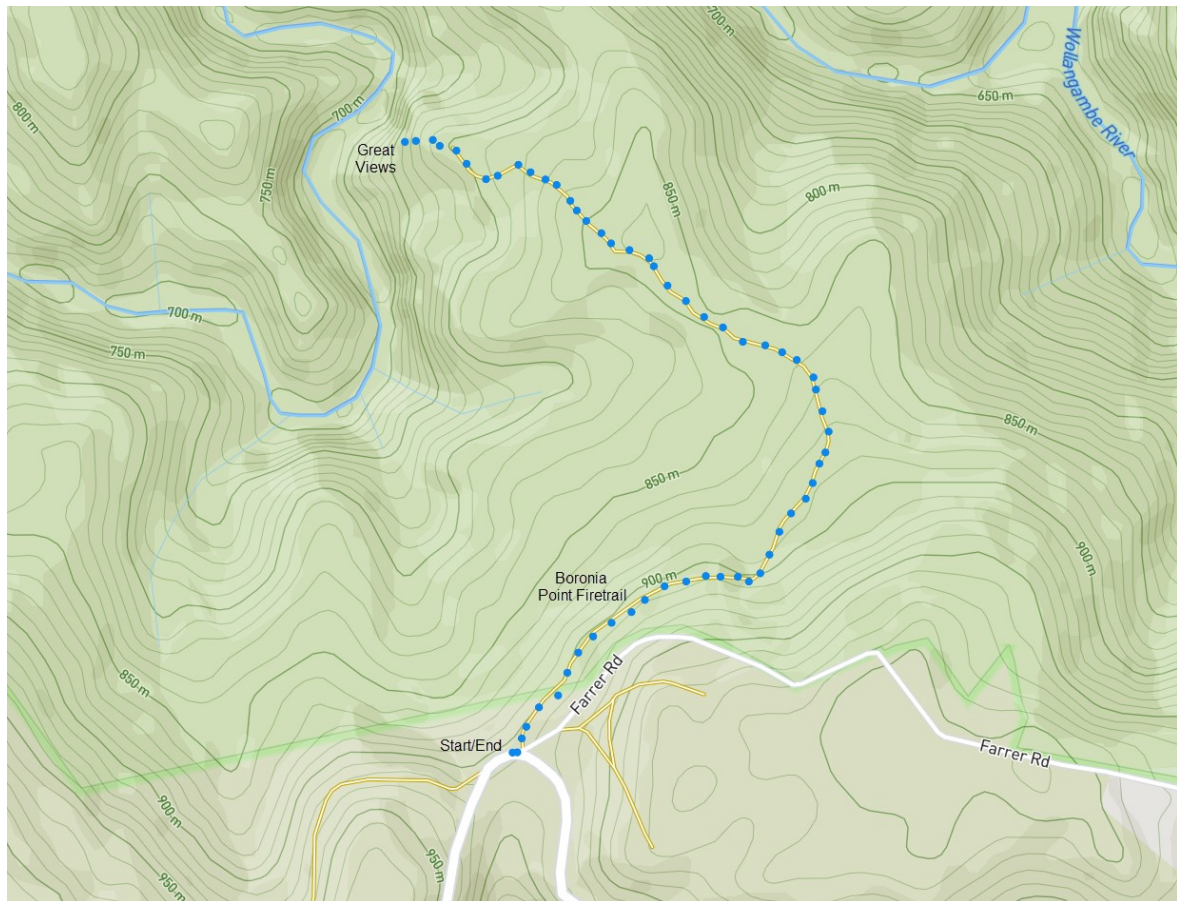
Car Park at Junction of Mt Irvine Road and Farrer Road West, about 2 km beyond the Cathedral of Ferns.

Walking conditions:

- Well formed track.

Highlights:

- Great views into the Wollangambe Canyon
- Lovely Wild Flowers October/November



The fire trail starts at the car park (you can park just off the side of the road) and heads below Farrer Road West. This section of the mountain was very badly burnt during the October 2013 fires and you can see how quickly the bush has regenerated.

Keep going to the end of the fire trail. At the end of the fire trail there is a track heading to the left where you can walk right to the edge of the cliff (proceed with caution) and look down into the Wollangambe River where it makes some spectacular S bends. A great spot for tea and cake.

There is an added bonus in October and November when the wild flowers are out as these are very lovely. Return along the same trail back to the start of the walk.
